Alesandrini, Gene	2006-2007	To establish a detailed curriculum for Italian-American Cultural Communication by pursuing an ethnographic study in Italy in the Umbrian region. To explore student and faculty exchanges with Italian universities.
Alesandrini, Joyce	2006-2007	To develop a curriculum on Italian music and art as evident in smaller and lesser known areas for future study abroad trips and to enhance the Arts and Humanities courses. Secondly, to pursue international exchanges for Muskingum students and faculty.
Burk, Margaret	Fall 2006	"Textbook Project: Marketing and the Visual Arts" To continue the preliminary work done over the past two years, consisting of a substantial bibliography and a detailed outline of chapters. Hopes to have most of the writing done by the end of the sabbatical
Golden, Gary	Spring 2007	To perform secondary and primary research that will study current methods of coursework, assignments, and evaluation of student learning, across both the introductory marketing principles course and upper-level marketing-based electives.
VanHorn, Stephen	Spring 2007	"Learning New Techniques and Technologies for Application to the Study of Recovering Surfaced-Mined Watersheds" To learn new research techniques and technologies from colleagues at the U. of Akron. Subsequently, applying these techniques to his work at The Wilds in conjunction with a Muskie Fellow.
Wilson, Joe	Fall 2006	To develop a textbook for an accounting course that covers both governmental auditing and accounting. Secondly, to research how federal grant programs are audited given the 'single audit' requirement.
