On the day of Graduation, the doors to Brown Chapel will open at 9 a.m. for the 10 a.m. Baccalaureate service.

The Anne C. Steele Center will open at 12:30 p.m. for the 1:30 p.m. Commencement ceremony.

Families with small children may find it more comfortable to watch Commencement on television in the VIP Lounge of the Anne C. Steele Center. Staff will be available to direct you to this location.

We have limited wheelchair/handicap seating available in designated areas in the gym. Due to the limited space however, only one other guest may accompany the person seated in this section.

## Shuttle Service

For your convenience, continuous shuttle service will be operated from remote parking areas to the quadrangle. Service will run from 9 a.m. - 5 p.m.

## Meals

A Continental Breakfast will be available in Patton Dining Hall from 8 a.m. - 9:30 a.m. Tickets are \$4.80 per person and can be purchased at the door.
