Admission Requirements include: Application to MU Education Program, B- or better in all EDUC classes, A minimum 2.67 cumulative GPA in all courses, Certificate for Computer Science and Computational Thinking, Admission dispositions Assessment (completed by faculty during first semester at MU), BCI/FBI Background on file, and Preservice Teacher Permit on file.
