THE TRANSFER PROCESS

Whether your interests have changed or you are making the transition from a community college, Muskingum University can help you complete your Bachelor's Degree. We are here to help guide you through the application, credit evaluation, financial aid, and other aspects of the transfer process. The transfer application process is straightforward and simple. You may apply online for free at muskingum.edu/apply.

We also require a transcript from every college/university you have attended. We eventually will need official* transcripts, but you may send us an unofficial transcript for the initial review. Please email unofficial transcripts as an attachment to jburnett@muskingum.edu. In addition, please request that your high school send us a final official* transcript.

**Official transcripts must be sent directly from the institution to Muskingum University electronically or in a sealed envelope.*

TRANSFER STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

OHIO TRANSFER MODULE

Muskingum University wants this process to be easy and smooth for you. To make this possible, we adhere to the Ohio Board of Regents Transfer and Articulation Policy. For students who have earned an Associate's Degree or at least 60 transferrable semester credit hours, the general education requirements at Muskingum will be replaced by the Ohio Transfer Module. This means you can complete your Bachelor's Degree in less time and focus on your major right away.

CREDIT TRANSFER POLICY

Upon admission to Muskingum, all previous college transcripts will be evaluated for potential transfer credit. Within a month of acceptance, the student will receive a Transfer Credit Evaluation indicating which classes have been transferred and the credit value for each.
