Math Placement & Muskie Previews

You must place for Pre-Calculus (MATH 180) or higher to start the four-year plan for the General Engineering major. Consequently, you will need to provide at least one of the following items to the Admission Office prior to your attendance at Muskie Previews:

- ACT Math score of 21 or higher (SAT Math score of 546 or higher)
- Earned college credit for an approved transfer course of Applied College Algebra (MATH 170)* or higher.
- AP Calculus AB score of 3 or higher.
- AP Calculus BC score of 3 or higher.
- Placement via Muskingum University Math Placement Exam.**

* If you plan on taking this course at another institution, check with the Registrar's Office first to make sure that Muskingum University will accept it for transfer.

** The Muskingum University Placement exam is only available to students who have deposited at Muskingum University. Offerings to take the exam begin in late spring of the year they plan to enroll. Students will receive an email about these offerings as soon as they are available.

Otherwise, you may be placed into Transitional Algebra (MATH 100) or Applied College Algebra (MATH 170). If this happens, you may need longer than four years to complete the major.
