


Every Step to Getting & Keeping SNAP Funds for College Students



The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) can help many college students with low or no incomes afford the healthy food they need to learn and succeed. More information is available at benefits.ohio.gov.



01 I GET A LETTER THAT TELLS ME I MIGHT BE ELIGIBLE FOR SNAP

based on my situation, or think I might be eligible.



02 I APPLY FOR SNAP AT BENEFITS.OHIO.GOV

or with help from a local foodbank, counselor on campus, or other assister.



03 I COMPLETE AN INTERVIEW WITH A CASEWORKER

after receiving a notice about my appointment.



04 I GET A NOTICE I AM APPROVED AND AN EBT CARD IN THE MAIL

that I activate following the instructions included.



05 MY CARD IS LOADED EACH MONTH AUTOMATICALLY

so I can shop for the foods I need at local retailers.



06 I VERIFY MY CONTINUING ELIGIBILITY EVERY 6 MONTHS

while I still need SNAP to help meet my basic needs.



Some of the most common documents I will need for my application and interview are:

- Proof of my identity and age (driver's license, photo ID card, passport, etc.)
- Proof of citizenship or immigration status (birth certificate, naturalization certificate, etc.)
- Proof of Social Security Number
- Proof of expenses, income, and resources (pay stubs for last 30 days, lease, utility bills, etc.)
- Copy of the letter from my college or institution

My Electronic Benefits Transfer (EBT) card, or Ohio Direction Card, looks like this. It works like a debit card and makes it easy to shop at one of more than 9,300 participating Ohio retailers.
