
A private space within the Impact Center that offers a quiet, private environment for professional interviews.

Hurst's Visit to Muskingum: Reflections on a Prolific Career

The Walter Humanitarian Fellows had the pleasure of hosting Dr. Mark Hurst '81 on October 18, 2023. Dr. Hurst is a psychiatrist and addiction specialist who has made significant contributions to public health advocacy. He has held various positions, including serving as the Medical Director for the Ohio Department of Health during the COVID-19 pandemic.



Career Advice from Dr. Mark Hurst

- Power of saying Yes
- Mission is Important
- All life events are opportunities to learn
- Assess where you are in life in regular intervals
- Have a mentor
- Deal with problems early
- The best work happens in teams
- Listen more than you talk
- Be polite to everyone always
- Help others be successful
- Be humble

During his visit to Muskingum, Dr. Hurst had the opportunity to speak with students, faculty, and staff. He shared valuable insights gained from his extensive experience in addressing the opioid crisis, navigating the scientific and political implications of COVID-19, and working in private practice. Dr. Hurst strongly advocates for teamwork, emphasizing that it often leads to the best outcomes when approached with a mission-oriented mindset and a systematic approach to achieving goals. We are honored to have Dr. Hurst as part of the Muskingum community and look forward to his continued mentorship of our students.
