

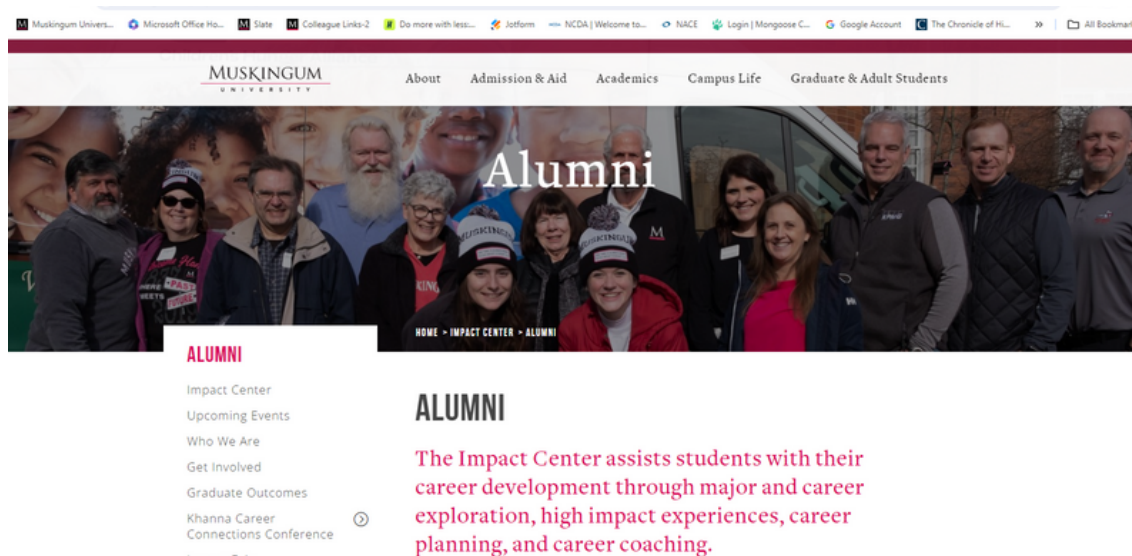

The program includes seminars, professional development, study tours, networking, and mentorship.



The deadline for applications for the upcoming fall semester is **March 28th, 2024**. The application process entails submitting an online form, a personal statement, a resume, a writing sample, and two letters of recommendation.

Interns in the program will reside together in a residence selected for its services, proximity to the Metro system, safety and neighborhood conveniences.
