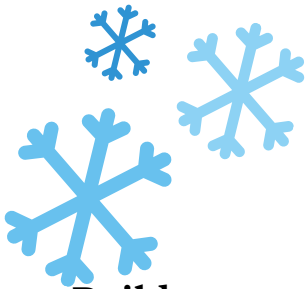

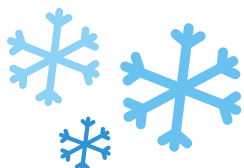
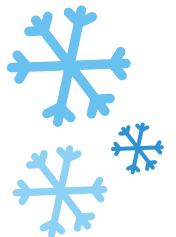

The Importance of Learning Interview Skills



Big Interview, an online resume review and interviewing platform, can help you master your interview skills. It's free to all Muskingum students and available 24/7. Pamela Skillings, Chief Product Officer at Big Interview, offers the following advice about interviewing:

The whole purpose of the job interview is to see if you are a good fit. And one of the top ways for interviewers to learn this is to ask behavioral questions.

With behavioral questions, they are looking to see how you behaved in scenarios in the past so that they can predict your behavior in the future.

These questions are easy to spot because they follow the same pattern:

- Tell me about a time when you...
- Have you ever been in a situation where...
- Can you give an example of a time when...

But, they also have a bad rep, because they ask you to:

- Give longer answers and tell stories.
- Pick great examples that showcase your best work.
- Stay focused while answering.
- This also means they require *real preparation*
