

MUSKINGUM UNIVERSITY POLICY ON AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES AND REASONABLE ACCOMMODATIONS

The Disability Education Office (DEO) provides federally mandated reasonable accommodations to students who have disabilities.

In accordance with Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1990, Muskingum University makes reasonable accommodations available to qualified students. Reasonable accommodations are provided at no charge to the student. Information received will not be used for any unlawful purpose.

Individuals with disabilities must self-identify, make known their requests for accommodation and, where required, provide documentation to the Coordinator of the Disability Education Office which is located in Walter Hall #26, at Muskingum University, 163 Stormont Street, New Concord, Ohio 43762.

The provision of reasonable accommodation is based on communication with the student and the review of submitted documentation, where required. The provision of accommodation is determined on an individual basis, and the Disability Education Office facilitates the accommodation.
