Commencement Speaker

ACADEMIC REGALIA

The wearing of academic regalia is a tradition of very long standing. The practice dates to the earliest European universities, perhaps originating as much from the practical concern for warmth in notoriously chilly facilities as from the desire to recognize and celebrate the teacher and holder of an advanced degree.

The level of the degree can be distinguished by the style of the gown. Gowns for all graduates are usually black. While undergraduate gowns may all seem the same, at the graduate level regalia tell a rich story of the graduate's academic journey. In American usage, the colors of the trim on the gown and the color of the hood indicate school and discipline: white for Arts and Letters, dark blue for Philosophy, golden yellow for Science, light blue for Education, scarlet for Theology, sage green for Physical Education, copper for Economics, and pink for Music.

HONOR CORDS

Honor cords identify graduates who have achieved special recognition for academic excellence. Graduates wear honor cords to signify their initiation into one of Muskingum University's honor societies and/or their achievement of President's List, Dean's List, or Academic Merit honors.
