

Graduate Assistant in Athletics for Cross Country/Track & Field

Muskingum University invites applications for a one-year appointment, with a one-year renewable appointment, as a graduate assistant coach in Men's and Women's Cross Country/Track & Field. The position is under the supervision of the Vice President and Director of Athletics, the Director of Track & Field Operations/Head Cross Country Coach, and the Head Track & Field Coach.

Duties include assisting with all phases of the men's and women's cross country/track & field programs, with an emphasis on throwing events, plus any additional duties as assigned by the Vice President and Director of Athletics.

This is a ten-month appointment, which begins August 1, 2021. Position includes graduate school tuition remission for Muskingum University, monthly stipend, University housing, and meal plan.

Candidates must possess a bachelor's degree and qualify for admission into Muskingum's graduate school program. Also required are a strong background in intercollegiate track & field, good organizational and time management skills, and excellent verbal and written communication skills. Candidate should possess a strong commitment to motivate, teach, counsel, and recruit student athletes within the guidelines of the NCAA and the Ohio Athletic Conference.
