PROFESSIONAL CONDUCT	Assessment of Professional Conduct I: to be admitted to the licensure program, a candidate must possess current acceptable BCI and FBI background checks in accordance with state and federal laws.	Assessment of Professional Conduct II: to engage in the Internship, a candidate must possess current acceptable BCI and FBI background checks in accordance with state and federal laws and as required by the respective school district(s).	Assessment of Professional Conduct III: to exit the licensure program, a candidate must possess current acceptable BCI and FBI background checks in accordance with state and federal laws in accordance with state licensure requirements.
PROFESSIONAL DISPOSITIONS			Assessment of Professional Dispositions (Key Program/Licensure Assessment #7): to exit the licensure program, a candidate must demonstrate professional dispositions at the conclusion of EDUC 772/773 with no rating at or below the <i>developing</i> level.
GENERAL KNOWLEDGE	Assessment of General Knowledge I: to be admitted to the licensure program, a candidate must possess a baccalaureate degree from a regionally-accredited institution with a GPA of 2.5 or higher and, if appropriate, possess a GPA of 3.0 or higher for all graduate coursework pursued.		Assessment of General Knowledge II: to exit the licensure program, a candidate must possess a master's degree from a regionally-accredited institution.
PROFESSIONAL KNOWLEDGE & SKILLS	Assessment of Professional Knowledge & Skills I: to be admitted to the licensure program, a candidate must (1) possess a professional teaching license and (2) provide documentation of at least one school year of teaching experience under a professional teaching license.	Assessment of Professional Knowledge & Skills II: to engage in the Internship, a candidate must (1) possess a cumulative G.P.A. of 3.0 or higher in all professional education courses required for the principal license (two courses per semester may be taken concurrent with internship), (2) have completed all professional education courses required for the principal license with grades of B- or higher, and (3) have completed all Key Program/Licensure Assessments administered prior to the Internship with at least 80% of the candidate proficiencies across assessments rated at the <i>meets</i> level and with no candidate proficiency rated <i>unacceptable</i> .	Assessment of Professional Knowledge & Skills III: to exit the licensure program, a candidate must (1) provide documentation of at least two years of teaching experience under a professional teaching license, (2) have completed all principal licensure program professional education course requirements, (3) possess a cumulative G.P.A. of 3.0 or higher in all professional education courses required for principal licensure, (4) have completed all professional education courses required for principal licensure with grades of B- or higher, (5) have completed all Key Program/Licensure Assessments administered during the Internship with at least 80% of the candidate proficiencies rated at the <i>meets</i> level and have no candidate proficiency rated <i>unacceptable</i> , AND (6) have passed the respective licensure test as set forth by the State Board of Education and implemented by the Ohio Department of Education.

NOTE: Evidence of completion of Key Assessments must be documented whether the associated course(s) is taken at Muskingum or at another institution.
