

The following is the Finding Aid for the Social and Historical Muskingum University Archive, which contains records and artifacts that pertain to the university's history, dating back to its founding in 1837. University archival materials reflect periods from the Civil War, Great Depression, both World Wars through to the present day, including artifacts from two of Muskingum University's famous alumni, Senator and Astronaut John Glenn '42 and Oscar-nominated and Emmy-winning actress Agnes Moorehead '23. The Social and Historical Muskingum University Archive also preserves the history of early Appalachian Ohio through diaries and other ephemera, genealogy, and the history of the Presbyterian Church and other Presbyterian colleges in Ohio.
